Many of you have fond memories of this historic Onalaska school along with the wonderful teachers and staff that worked there. This is a unique opportunity for the community to purchase a keepsake brick from this historic Onalaska school and give back to the Onalaska Education Foundation. This school joined the Onalaska School District in 1960 and was used as an elementary school until 1983 when it became the Fauver Hill Kindergarten Center, housing all the kindergartners in the district. The Center closed in 1999. It will be demolished by Gundersen Health System to make way for future health facilities.

We are selling a limited number of historic bricks for \$20 or three for \$50. Each brick will have a Fauver Hill commemorative plate.
